

Available Teaching Positions: Shokutaku Jokyo II (Assistant Professor of English and Cultural Studies)

The Faculty of International Communication, Aichi University, Nagoya, Japan, invites applications for the positions of Shokutaku Jokyo II (Teacher of English and Cultural Studies in the Department of Global Liberal Arts) on the conditions given below.

This position is not a permanent teaching position. The contract is for twelve months renewable for four more years maximum:

1. Status:

Shokutaku Jokyo II (Assistant Professor of English and Cultural Studies in the Department of Global Liberal Arts).

2. Qualifications:

A) Native speaker of English.

B) Cultural Studies or related field. TESOL and/or ESL/EFL training/experience desirable.

C) M.A. or its equivalent required.

D) Once employed, the successful applicant will be expected to reside within an 80kilometer radius of Nagoya campus.

3.Number of positions:

1

4.Employment period:

12-month contract: From April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.

Renewable annually up to four times (total of five years)

5.Teaching courses:

Cultural Studies; Media Studies; Popular Culture; Multicultural Studies; 1st year Seminar; 2nd year Seminar.

6.Duties:

A) Responsible hours of teaching:Two semesters (From April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021) 20 classes of 90 minutes per academic year (Preseminar II for sophomores, Seminar II for juniors, Introduction to Cultural Studies, Multiculturalism Studies, in the spring; Preseminar I for freshmen, Seminar I for sophomores, Rituals and ceremonies, Culture through the arts, in the fall), 20 additional hours per week in both spring and fall semesters for other responsibilities such as offering English classes in the Global Lounge and mock lectures during open campus. In addition, one or two

day(s) during Summer break in August for open campus lessons, and Spring break in March for English classes for incoming freshmen. Thus, a total number of working hours is 20 classes of 90 minutes per academic year which is 1,800 hours a year or 900 a semester, and 20 hours of additional works per semester or 40 hours per year.

B) Working hours:35 hours a week on campus, hours of teaching included.

C) In principle, part-time work elsewhere should not be undertaken.

7. Payments:

A) ¥450,000/ month.

B) Research subsidy of ¥200,000 will be paid. This is intended to be spent on, for example, books, stationery, attendance at conferences etc.

8. Travel and relocation expenses:

(1) Teachers living abroad:When a teacher comes from abroad, one international economy class round-trip ticket per position will be paid between your present place of residence and Nagoya (Chubu International Airport), Osaka (Kansai International Airport) or Tokyo (Narita International Airport). Maximum round-trip fare is ¥150,000. In addition, Aichi University will pay the full public transportation costs from one of the three international airports to the new place of residence.

(2) Teachers living in Japan:

a) For teachers living in Japan the full public transport costs from the present place of residence to the new place of residence will be paid. (excluding family)

b) A contribution towards relocation expenses will be paid according to the distance from the present place of residence to anywhere within an 80-kilometer radius of Nagoya.

9. Accommodation:

(1) Teachers living abroad:Aichi University will provide accommodation for teachers coming from abroad, if required.

(2) Teachers living in Japan:Teachers living in Japan are expected to make their own arrangements concerning accommodation, which should be within an 80-kilometer radius of Nagoya.

10. Social insurance:

Employees are required to join the Mutual Aid Association of Private School Personnel (health insurance and other benefits). Premium payments will be paid half by the university and half by the individual.

11. Deadline for application:

August 30, 2019 (All application must be postmarked on or before August 30)

12. Application procedures:

Please send a Resume/ CV with photograph attached, with covering letter, a short essay explaining your ideas for teaching Cultural Studies in English to Japanese university students, and two reference letters. After screening, interviews will be conducted. The applicants selected for an interview will be informed by telephone/ fax/ e-mail.
