Class Name	Japanese I (A) [Grammar/Reading Comprehension I]
Offered Semester	Fall Semester
Topic	Learning intermediate level Japanese “Grammar and Expression” and master reading comprehension skills.
Class Outline	Students first master basic Japanese grammar and then go on learning intermediate Japanese grammar through textbooks. Regular writing and speaking practices will be done constantly to help students to practically use the learned grammar. For reading comprehension exercises, students will read short passages and understand the general contents of texts. Content review tests will be done after learning every chapter.
Objectives	Develop ability to use beginners’ and intermediate level Japanese grammar within everyday life. Reading comprehension exercises require students to read short passages aloud, building their familiarity with Japanese pronunciation, and helping them to achieve a general understanding of texts.
