

Japanese Course for Foreign Exchange Students Syllabus

Class Name	Japanese II (A) [Grammar/Reading Comprehension II]
Offered Semester	Fall Semester
Topic	Learning intermediate level Japanese “Grammar and Expression” and master reading comprehension skills.
Class Outline	This class is for students that have finished learning basic Japanese grammar and the 100 words of basic Kanji and also has achieved four skills within beginners’ level. This class aims to develop student’s 4 skills (Listen/Talk/Read/Write) up to intermediate level by learning Japanese grammar and expression, and master reading comprehension skills. The class will help review grammars if the students discover any grammar learned before but has not been fully mastered. Grammar exercises require students to think and answer sentences which meanwhile extends to conversation practices.
Objectives	Develop ability to use beginners’ and intermediate level Japanese grammar within everyday life. Reading comprehension exercises require students to read short passages aloud, building their familiarity with Japanese pronunciation, and helping them to achieve a general understanding of texts.
