Class Name	Japanese IV (A) [Composition/Learning Kanji]
Offered Semester	Fall Semester
Topic	Learning Japanese composition and Kanji.
Class Outline	<p>Firstly students will master basic kanji covered in <i>GENKI II</i> textbook. Students then go on learning kanji from <i>Intermediate Japanese</i> textbook and research the spelling, definition and how to write and use related compound words. The class also review kanji and related compound words used in the textbook from conversation and reading comprehension sections. Students will practice writing compositions based on topics relating the learned kanji and compound words. This will help students to use and output the kanji learned in class. The written composition will be corrected by teachers which help students to master the correct use of kanji.</p>
Objectives	<p>This class aims to develop student's strength in mastering the spelling, definition and how to write kanji and increase scores of each kanji review tests. The review test aims to help students review weak areas of kanji regarding the test results.</p> <p>Composition writing aims to develop writing skills by writing about topics of vocabulary learned in class. The teacher's correction to the composition will help students to recheck mistaken grammar, vocabulary and expressions. This will further develop student's skills of Japanese and aiming for a level of Japanese that is equivalent to N2 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test.</p>
