Class Name	Japanese VI (B) [Discovering Traditional Japan]
Offered Semester	Spring Semester
Topic	Learning Traditional Japanese Culture
Class Outline	Students carry out research on 3 topics of traditional Japanese culture such as traditional crafts, arts and costumes. The students then are required to present their findings to the class by delivering a presentation. There will also be workshops to experience referring to the topics and facts learned in class. This will help students to further understand about the facts by learning from a specialist. After experiencing the activities, reports are required to be handed in and presented in class for discussion with other students.
Objectives	<p>The aim of this class is to develop the following 4 skills through understanding Japanese traditional culture.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To individually research and present about Japanese traditional culture. - To understand explanation from the specialist and ask questions to expand your understanding. - To write up a report about facts learned in the workshops. - To present your report and be able to do discussions.
